Dear Parents and Cadets,

Thank you for choosing to attend NSCC Master-at-Arms or Air Traffic Control Training at Naval Air Station Kingsville TX. (17 to 30 June 07) In order to make this time with us most productive, we ask that you be aware of the following information, rules and procedures.

The local airport is in Corpus Christi TX. Training Check-In begins at 1:00 (1300.) Cadets who fly in should plan to arrive after that time or be prepared to wait at the Airport. We cannot accept cadets who must have a pre-arranged escort.

FOLLOW THE SEA BAG LIST. Other items will be confiscated and returned after Graduation. Cadets can bring an inexpensive camera and cash for shopping and Listed Sea Bag items to be purchased. All valuables WILL BE locked up in the Sea Bag. Cadets will travel in civilian clothes and be prepared to shift into Utilities immediately upon arrival to the base.

Please send us an email address that we can use for current updates to the family. Send an email subject line "MAA COMMUNICATIONS" to MAATXMailCall@aol.com Do that now so we can confirm transportation information to the training. SEND FLIGHT INFO TO THIS ADDRESS WE MUST KNOW YOUR SCHEDULE. Your airport drivers and cadet escorts will be wearing a YELLOW T-Shirt or Khaki Shirt with NSCC Logo.

Cadets will have limited use of our phones. Expect two calls – one to confirm arrival and one to update graduation and departure. You will not receive a first day call if you drove your cadet to the training. Those calls will be made on our cell phones. My phone 361-814-NAVY is your emergency contact number and is a local call from the Corpus Christi Airport area (814-6289). Cadets who travel with a cell phone must turn it in immediately upon arrival at Sea Cadet Check-In. You should call your parents as you arrive at the airport. Phones will be returned after Graduation.

You may use the MAATXMAILCALL@aol.com to send a FEW email messages to your cadet. THIS SERVICE SOLELY DEPENDS ON AN ADEQUATE E-MAIL CONNECTION. These messages will be opened, printed and delivered by an officer or staff cadet. The cadet will not be able to send email but the command will reply if necessary. There MAY BE Training Updates and "News" sent to those who have responded. The cadet may mail letters home.

Graduation, "Pass and Review" will be held on Sunday, 30 June 2007 at 1000 hrs at The Club. Friends and relatives are cordially invited to attend this time-honored tradition. More information will be emailed the last week. Cadets will depart NAS Kingsville after the Graduation. No flight should be scheduled until after 1400 (2:00PM).

THESE ARE INTENSELY PHYSICAL AND DETAIL-ORIENTED TRAINING – 8-week Navy Courses condensed into 14 days. Cadets will be expected to adhere to the standards set by their Navy Trainers. Strict military protocol will be observed at all times. Anyone who fails to meet the School's high standards or personal behavior will be sent home. There will be no second offenders.
