Dear Parents and Cadets,

Thank you for choosing to attend NSCC Recruit Training (1-10 June 2007) and League Cadet Orientation(3-10 June 2007) at Naval Air Station Kingsville. In order to make this time with us most productive, we ask that you be aware of the following information, rules and procedures.

The local airport is in Corpus Christi TX. Training Check-In begins at 1:00 (1300.) Cadets who fly in should plan to arrive after that time or be prepared to wait at the Airport. We cannot accept cadets who must have a pre-arranged escort. Your airport drivers and cadet escorts will be wearing a YELLOW T-Shirt or Blue Polo Shirt with NSCC Logo.

FOLLOW THE SEA BAG LIST. Other items are not needed and WILL BE CONFISCATED. Cadets can bring an inexpensive camera and cash for shopping and Listed Sea Bag items you need to purchase. All valuables WILL BE locked up in the Sea Bag. Cadets must travel in civilian clothes and be prepared to shift into Utilities immediately upon arrival to the base.

Cadets will have limited use of our phones. Expect two calls – one to confirm arrival and one to update graduation and departure. You will not receive a first day call if you drove your cadet to the training. If you are also driving other cadets, make sure they call home before you depart. My phone – 361-814-NAVY is your emergency contact number and is a local call from the Corpus Christi Airport area (814-6289). Cadets who travel with a cell phone must turn it in immediately upon arrival at Sea Cadet Check-In. Cadets should call parents as they arrive at the airport. Phones will be returned after Graduation.

You may use [NSCCRegion85RT @aol.com](mailto:NSCCRegion85RT@aol.com) to send a FEW IMPORTANT email messages to your cadet. These messages will be opened, read and delivered by an officer. The cadet will not be able to send email but the command will reply if necessary. There may be Training Updates and "News" sent to all who have responded. THIS SERVICE SOLELY DEPENDS ON AN ADEQUATE INTERNETCONNECTION at Training. The cadet may mail letters home. We will provide a snail mail address closer to when the training opens.

Graduation, "Pass and Review" will be held on Sunday, 10 June 2007 - 1000 at NAS. Friends and relatives are cordially invited to attend this time-honored tradition. More information will be emailed the before the training. Cadets will depart NAS Kingsville immediately after the Graduation. Flights should not be scheduled before 2:00. Sunday afternoon

THIS IS AN INTENSELY PHYSICAL AND DETAIL-ORIENTED TRAINING – Cadets are expected to arrive ABLE TO PASS NSCC PT Requirements and without medication or physical injury. Cadets are encouraged to complete the BMR before Recruit Training. Cadets are expected to adhere to the standards set by the NSCC RT Command. Strict military protocol will be observed at all times. Anyone who fails to meet the NSCC's standards of personal behavior will be sent home.
